Recycling - Jan. 10 & 24, Feb. 7 & 21, Mar. 6 & 20 **GREEN NOTE** by Jeanine Lindberg. One good thing about winter weather is that yards don't need mowing every week or so. However, there are things that you can do during the cold months to ensure a healthy lawn in the spring. The best thing for keeping grass healthy is to increase the height of the lawn mower blade. Taller grass with more blade area means more exposure to the sun for photosynthesis, a plant process that turns sunlight into food from carbon dioxide and water. It also creates green pigment and oxygen. Taller grass in the summer protects fragile roots from drying out or dying. Seeding in our area should be done in late spring after danger of frost or early summer. Good luck with your 2020 lawn!

BLACK HISTORY MONTH



Protect Your Pipes This Winter!



- . Wrap exposed pipes with insulating material.
- . Locate your inside water shut-off valve, if your home has one, and tag it so it's clearly identifiable.
- . If your house has a crawl space, cover outside vents to prevent winter winds from freezing pipes.
- . Keep the garage door closed. Some water pipes are located under concrete garage floors.
- . Drip it. Keep water moving with a small trickle.







